In some instances, you may be required to work outdoors. However, it's important that you never put yourself in danger and always have a plan to seek shelter in the event inclement weather arrives. Follow the tips below when working outdoors:

If you are outdoors when inclement weather starts, see lightning, or hear thunder, seek shelter immediately, such as in a building or vehicle.

Never use electrically-powered tools or equipment or perform electrical work in wet conditions to avoid shock hazards.

Never work on a ladder or elevated surface (e.g., rooftop) in wet or windy conditions to avoid the risk of falling.
